

Jacques entered France's Ministry of Health as a pharmacist inspector in Public Health. Following study in the School of Advanced Studies in Public Health, he held various positions in the management of narcotics and drugs for veterinary use. Then he joined the local inspectorate for Public Health before returning to the Ministry of Health, as deputy to the head of the pharmacist inspectors corps.

In 1993, he joined the newly created drug agency where, over 25 years, he held inspection positions. For 18 years, Jacques participated in the European construction of GMP inspection and in the development of the "Pharmaceutical Inspection Cooperation Scheme (PIC/S)" which he chaired for 4 years. He was also involved in the ICH Q9 and Q10 documents. He finished his (full time) career as Deputy Director of Inspection in 2018, continuing part-time as technical advisor for the inspection division on European subjects and internationally on ICH and PIC/S. He currently chairs the PIC/S sub-committee on training and is a member of its executive bureau.
